Q: HOW DO I FIND OUT IF I'M ELIGIBLE FOR WORK-STUDY?

If you applied for financial aid through the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships, you can check whether they awarded you work-study funds on your "My Aid Award" page.

Q: WHERE DO I GO TO GET MORE INFORMATION ABOUT WORK-STUDY AWARDS?

The Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships provides detailed information about using work-study funds on your "My To-Do List" page.

Q: WHERE DO I FIND WORK-STUDY JOBS?

The Division of Career Pathways can help you search for the right work-study job through their professional staff, peer advisors, and online via Handshake.

Q: WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T USE MY WORK-STUDY?

If you fail to use your work-study, you run the risk of losing it.

Q: IS IT POSSIBLE TO WORK OFF CAMPUS AND EARN WORK-STUDY?

There are a limited number of positions off campus that offer work-study. Check Handshake for the most up to date listings of available positions.

Q: CAN I WORK IN TWO DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS AND STILL COLLECT WORK-STUDY?

Yes, but you have to collect a signed agreement form from each department.
