JUNIOR YEAR

- Attend workshops throughout the year (e.g. resume, interviewing, internship search)
- Attend the Graduate and Professional School Fairs and Internship and Career Fair
- · Maintain a high GPA
- Get a job, internship, or volunteer position relating to your career interests
- Research specific job positions or graduate schools
- Update your resume



- Check graduate schools for prerequisite course requirements (if you are planning on attending graduate school)
- Ask your references for letters of recommendation
- Prepare for or take required graduate school exam(s)
