Application Timeline & Checklist

FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE YEARS

- □ Visit the Division of Career Pathways to explore health-related resources
- □ Complete your requirements in:
 - Chemistry
 - Biology
 - □ Physics
 - Organic Chemistry
- Join a health-related club on campus
- □ Begin volunteer work to gain experience
- $\hfill\square$ Seek out professors to find research experience
- $\hfill\square$ Get involved in community service
- $\hfill\square$ Keep your career options open

FOR ALL FOUR YEARS

- Every spring quarter, attend DCP's Health
 Professions Series events (career.uci.edu/healthprofessions-week) including the Health
 Professions and Graduate School Fair (career.uci.edu/undergraduate/find-a-job/careerfairs)

JUNIOR YEAR

- □ Complete your health profession admission requirements by the end of spring quarter
- Attend a "Letter of Recommendation Workshop" through the School of Biological Sciences
- □ Prepare and take the health school admissions test (e.g. DAT, MCAT, OAT, PCAT, or GRE) that is required by the school you are applying to
- Contact professors to write individual letters of recommendation
- Begin your application and create a rough draft of your personal statement by May
- □ At the end of spring quarter, send your official transcript to the application service or schools (upon request)

SUMMER BEFORE SENIOR YEAR

- Submit health school applications early do not wait until the end of the summer
- Take the DAT / MCAT / OAT / PCAT / GRE if not already completed

<u>SENIOR YEAR – FALL QUARTER</u>

- □ Secondary packets are sent to potential candidates, with request for letters of recommendation
- $\hfill\square$ Check and make sure applications are complete and letters have been received
- □ Invitations for interviews are offered (September April)
 - □ Practice by participating in 1:1 practice interviews at the Division of Career Pathways
- $\hfill\square$ Complete forms for financial aid
- $\hfill\square$ Send updated transcripts if requested by schools

<u>SENIOR YEAR – FALL QUARTER</u>

- □ Finish all outstanding application requests by schools (interviews, financial aid, transcripts)
- □ Send thank you notes to evaluators and mentors
- □ If you have decided to wait another year to apply, consider enhancements to be a more competitive (raise your GPA, retake the MCAT, gain more experience, do more research, etc.)
- □ Consider alternative career options and learn the job search process (if not accepted)

Keep in mind, this is a suggested timeline – your individual deadlines may vary depending on the schools you apply to.
