HANDSHAKE

The Division of Career Pathways utilizes Handshake as its campus career management platform. Handshake is the first point of engagement to facilitate connection with the UCI student community. Maximize your visibility and create awareness around full-time, part-time, seasonal, and short-term jobs and internships by posting your opportunities to Handshake. When posting opportunities, employers can specify candidate criteria, collect and view resumes via the online system, and allow students to search and apply for opportunities. Handshake access also allows industry partners to remain up to date with campus activities such as large- and small-scale recruitment events, career fair registrations, and submitting requests for campus interviews and information sessions.

CAMPUS INTERVIEWS

Campus interviews are a complimentary service offering that provides another opportunity to promote your brand on campus and allows you to interview a schedule of talented and career-ready UCI students in an efficient manner, virtually or in-person. Interviews are offered during designated recruitment windows outlined in advance from the quarterly academic calendar. This program is reserved for employers looking to fill full-time career positions or full-time paid internships.

In-person interviews are held between 9:00am-4:00pm PST on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays during designated weeks of each quarter with a dedicated Employer Relations staff member available onsite to provide support as needed. For successful campus recruitment, we suggest partners leverage other recruitment events or services prior to conducting interviews to increase or secure an applicant pool.

Campus interviews are a complimentary service to all employers interested in recruiting from UCI.

INFORMATION SESSIONS

Hosting an information session is a great way to establish an organizational presence on campus and provide students with information about jobs, internships, and career development opportunities at your organization. Information sessions can be especially effective when executed in partnership with student organizations, featuring alumni from your organization, or pre/post-Career Fair attendance.

Information sessions are scheduled for 60 minutes. A dedicated staff member from the Employer Relations team will serve as the day of event host to provide additional support. Marketing support provided for information sessions includes:

- Event highlight in weekly newsletter that goes out to all undergraduate UCI students plus select alumni who opted to continue engaging with Career Services after graduating.
- Email promotion to relevant DCP Club Affiliates (student organizations that have partnered with DCP to promote professional development among their membership)
- Highlight in Instagram story one week before event, 2-3 days before event, and day of event if applicable
- Dedicated Employer Relations staff member to support coordinating and hosting of event

Information sessions must be submitted and approved in Handshake. Requests must be submitted at least 4-6 weeks in advance to allow time for coordination and marketing.

BUILD YOUR BRAND

CUSTOMIZED MAILINGS

Strategically promote your Handshake job or internship posting with targeted email communications. This offering supports recruitment needs that may arise throughout the year, beyond the scope of programming and recruitment events. It allows partners to promote and source talent for open roles with a tailored approach. These targeted emails consist of a customized message to a select group of students via Handshake based on employer partner specifications.

- Limit of one (1) unique email per quarter / three (3) per year, up to an audience size of 5,000 students.
- Requests must be submitted at least 4-6 weeks in advance to allow time for coordination and marketing.
- May not be combined with other services.

Cost: \$250.00

BRANDING PACKAGE

A Branding Package offers employers the chance to expand their reach to build traction around your recruitment visits and/or employment opportunities. This package is eligible for organizations wanting extra marketing support for a DCP hosted information session, an approved job/internship posting in Handshake, or for organizations with anticipated recruitment needs wanting campus visibility to build their brand. This package includes:

- A customized mailing up to an audience size of 5,000 students
- Weekly Newsletter Spotlight (goes out to all undergraduate UC students plus select alumni who opted to continue engaging with Career Services after graduating)
- Event highlight
- Customized company blurb promoting your organization (character limits apply)
- Job/internship highlight (limited to 1 opportunity; must be approved in Handshake and open to accepting applications)
- Email promotion to relevant DCP Club Affiliates (student organizations that have partnered with DCP to promote professional development among their membership)
- Highlight in Instagram story one week before event, 2-3 days before event, and day of event if applicable
- Event/posting promotion to campus liaisons
- Dedicated Employer Relations staff member to support coordinating and hosting of event (if applicable)

Limited quantities available per quarter. May not be combined with other services. Requests must be submitted at least 6-8 weeks in advance to allow time for coordination and marketing.

CONNECT


